



- 1- A.S. DIRINON association organize on *23<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of may 2015* an international tournament for **U 11** (born between 01/01/2004 and 31/12/2005) categorie and U12F (born between 01/01/2003 on 31/12/2005), according to the general regulations of the FFF (article 66).
- 2- The matches follow the French Football Federation (F.F.F.) rules. However, the offside rule is cancelled and all the free kicks are direct. The goalkeeper can not catch the ball in hand on a pass made by a teammate. The penalty is a direct free kick 13 meters in front of goal with walls 6 meters  
The goalkeeper can kick away in the hand or in the foot (The releases of beating or half-beating are authorized)
- 3- Referees from F.F.F. or A.S. Dirinon manage the matches while sideline referees are supplied by the teams (until the quarter final). The referee's decision is final.
- 4- Each team must be able to present the licences of all the players to the opponent team if required.
- 5- Game time : 2 X 7 minutes.
- 6- Each club must have 2 sets of shirts of different colours. Before the kick-off, if the referee considers that the colours of the shirts are not different enough, the first named team will have to play in another colour.
- 7- Each team is composed of a maximum of 11 players (8 + 3 substitutes) for the U11 categorie. Except infringement written and signed by the organizing committee of the Tournament.
- 8- A red card (sending off) or yellow card distributed to a player will be systematically communicated to the tournament organizers after the match. A player having received 1 red card or 2 yellow cards in the previous games will be suspended for the following match.

- 9- If one team is not present in time on the field, the match will be declared lost with a score of 3-0, except in case of major necessity.
- 10- The teams are divided into 9 groups of 5 teams.
- 11- The 2 leading teams of each group are qualified for the main tournament as well as the 6 best thirds. The qualified teams are divided into 8 groups of 3 teams. The 2 leading teams of each group are qualified for the 1/8 final.  
One win is 3 points, a draw is 1 point, and a defeat is 0 point. One penalty or forfeit is 0 point.  
If many teams get the same number of points, the teams will be settled due to their goal average (goals for - goals against).  
In case of equal goal average, the team having scored the most goals in the group will win. If the teams are still equal, the result between both the team will be decisive.  
"Non qualified teams after first day of the tournament on Saturday will participate in the defeated team tournament on Sunday. All players are winners!"
- 12- Since the 1/8 final, the elimination are direct. In case of the two teams draw, they settle by the penalty shots (3 different players) on a dedicated field.
- 13- All cases not mentioned in the rules will be settled by the tournament organisation.
- 14- The organisers of the tournament don't take any responsibilities in the case on damage, the loss of any object belonging to one of the teams or participants.
- 15- Each team will have to participate in the delegations parade on Saturday morning.*
- 16- Each delegation commits itself to take an insurance policy covering all players and adults against health problem or accident which could occur during the stay (medical treatment or repatriation).
